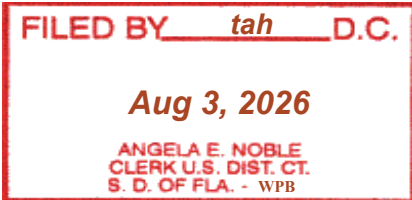

ORDER OF SUSPENSION



On July 27, 2026, the Supreme Court of Florida entered an Order of Suspension [ECF No. 1], suspending Steven Klaus Teuber from the practice of law. *See Fla. Bar v. Teuber*, No. SC2026-1123, 2026 WL 2150689, at *1 (Fla. July 27, 2026). The suspension followed a Notice of Determination or Judgment of Guilt [ECF No. 2], that disclosed Mr. Teuber was adjudicated guilty on June 29, 2026 of aggravated stalking and the installation of tracking devices or tracking applications, both third-degree felonies. (*See id.* ¶ 4).

Under Rule 7(a) of the Southern District of Florida Local Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys (“Attorney Rules”), “[u]pon the filing with this Court of a certified copy of a judgment of conviction demonstrating that any attorney admitted to practice before the Court has been convicted in any court of the United States[] . . . of any serious crime . . . the Court shall enter an order immediately suspending that attorney[.]” *Id.* (alterations added). Under Attorney Rule 7(b), a “serious crime” “include[s] any felony[.]” *Id.* (alterations added; quotation marks omitted).

Considering the above, and under Attorney Rules 7(a) and (b) and the Court’s inherent authority to oversee membership in its bar and safeguard the public interest, *see Chambers v. NASCO, Inc.*, 501 U.S. 32, 43 (1991) (citation omitted), it is

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ORDERED as follows:

1. Mr. Teuber is suspended from the practice of law in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida, effective immediately. He may not resume practice before this Court unless and until reinstated by court order. *See* Att’y R. 12(a).
2. Within **fourteen (14) days** of receipt of this Order, Mr. Teuber shall notify the Clerk of Court of any active cases in which he appears as counsel or co-counsel of record in this District.
3. The Clerk is directed to **STRIKE** Mr. Teuber from the roll of attorneys authorized to practice before this Court and to immediately revoke his CM/ECF credentials.
4. The Clerk shall promptly attempt service of this Order via certified mail to Mr. Teuber’s court record address and any address on file with The Florida Bar.
