Although plaintiff requested a 60-day extension of time to respond to the motion for summary judgment, the court granted only a two-week extension to July 20, 2020 because: (1) plaintiff's allegations that a COVID-19 lockdown had frustrated his ability to obtain legal materials to prepare his response lacked specificity; (2) his allegations did not support a finding that he could not file an inmate request to obtain any legal materials that he may need; and (3) while he alleged that the lockdown had prevented him from obtaining the assistance of an inmate law clerk, the record of this case showed that he had the wherewithal to prosecute the same. ECF No. 92. On the extended July 20, 2020 deadline, plaintiff filed a motion for a 45-day extension of time to file a response to the motion for summary judgment. ECF No. 96. Although plaintiff again alleges that the lockdown at his prison has prevented him from preparing a response, he admits that "inmates can make a request asking for copies of legal materials they need." ECF No. 96 at 2. To the extent he alleges that there is a delay in obtaining such materials, see <i>id.</i> , his allegations are vague and unsupported. He does not reasonably explain what steps, if any, he has taken to make such requests or provide a timeline of any such efforts. Furthermore, he alleges that he needs more time so that he can obtain affidavits to support his response. <i>Id.</i> at 3-4. However, discovery ended on April 6, 2020. ECF No. 59. In short, plaintiff has not shown good cause to extend the July 20, 2020 deadline to respond to the motion for summary judgment. Defendants apparently believe that because they incorporated their statement of material facts (DE#82) by reference on page one of their consolidated motion for summary judgment that they are relieved of their obligation to provide pinpoint citations to the record for ALL factual assertions in their consolidated motion for summary judgment. They are mistaken. Having to flip back and forth between the consolidated motion for summary judgment and the statement of material facts in search of citations to evidence supporting defendants' factual assertions is unduly burdensome and time-consuming and has seriously interfered with the court's ability to effectively and efficiently review their motion. Therefore, it is hereby ORDERED that defendants file a second consolidated motion for summary judgment in which they provide PINPOINT citations to the record for ALL FACTUAL ASSERTIONS. By record, the court means the docket entry number AND specific page and/or paragraph where the evidence supporting the factual assertion can be found. Defendants' second consolidated motion for summary judgment is due by June 5, 2020. Furthermore, all provisions of DE#81 shall remain in full force and effect. Signed by Magistrate Judge
