This matter has been referred to the undersigned for disposition of all non-dispositive motions and report and recommendation on dispositive motions. See ECF No. 7 at 1. Relevant to the Motions, in January 2023, the District Judge found Third-Party Orit Tal ("Ms. Tal") in contempt for failure to comply with Petitioner's subpoena. See generally ECF No. 13 (the "Contempt Order"). Ms. Tal was ordered to appear for her deposition or incur a \$200 daily fine until she complied. Id. at 2. Thereafter, Ms. Tal filed a 36 Motion to Vacate Contempt Orders (the "Motion to Vacate") and Petitioner filed a 41 Notice of Expiration of [Time] to Comply with this Court's Order Compelling Attendance at Deposition [and] Motion for Hearing to Show Cause (the "Motion for Hearing"). The Motions were set for hearing on May 15, 2024, at 10 AM. See ECF No. 52, 56.  The Court, however, recently granted Ms. Tal's 57 Motion for Referral to Volunteer Attorney Program. See ECF No. 58. Thus, in the interest of justice and efficient case management, the hearing is CONTINUED to allow: (i) Ms. Tal to potentially obtain counsel; and (ii) sufficient time for potential counsel's preparation. Further, to accommodate the parties' availability and the Court's existing schedule, the hearing is RE-SCHEDULED to Wednesday, August 14, 2024, at 2 PM before U.S. Magistrate Judge Alicia O. Valle, 299 East Broward Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, Courtroom 310. See ECF No. 55 at 2 (noting Petitioner's counsel's availability). No further continuances will be granted absent compelling circumstances.
		Accordingly, Ms. Tal's <u>36</u> Motion to Vacate is <b>DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE</b> . If necessary, <b>by Monday, July 15, 2024</b> , Ms. Tal may file a renewed motion, including factual and legal support for her request to vacate the Contempt Order, to be heard at the August hearing. Lastly, Petitioner's <u>41</u> Motion for Hearing is <b>GRANTED</b> and the hearing is scheduled on August 14, 2024. Signed by Magistrate Judge Alicia O. Valle on 5/13/2024. In the interest of efficient case management, a response to the Motion is unnecessary. Because a civil litigant has no constitutional right to counsel, the appointment of counsel is discretionary and warranted only under exceptional circumstances, "such as where the facts and legal issues are so novel or complex as to require the assistance of a trained practitioner." <i>Dean v. Barber</i> , 951 F.2d 1210, 1216 (11th Cir. 1992); <i>see Bass v. Perrin</i> , 170 F.3d 1312, 1320 (11th Cir. 1999). Where, as here, there are no such exceptional circumstances, the Court may nevertheless refer the civil matter to the Volunteer Attorney Program ("VAP"), which allows volunteer attorneys to accept representation on a <i>pro bono</i> basis if they desire. <i>See, e.g., Pena Bejerano v. GEO Care, LLC</i> , 21-CV-22361, 2021 WL 3539996, at *1 (S.D. Fla. July 1, 2021); <i>Miller v. Severson</i> , 20-CV-14370, 2021 WL 11703006, at *1 (S.D. Fla. Jan. 29, 2021); <i>Neal v. Wilson</i> , 18-CV-20374, 2019 WL 13412398, at *1 (S.D. Fla. Feb. 25, 2019). Accordingly, the Motion is <b>GRANTED</b> , and this matter shall be <b>REFERRED</b> to the VAP, where a volunteer attorney may accept the representation on a <i>pro bono</i> basis if

		desired. The Clerk of Court is directed to obtain a description of the case and contact information for Ms. Tal to post on the Court's website of available <i>pro bono</i> cases seeking volunteer lawyers. If the representation is accepted, the volunteer attorney shall enter an appearance in the case and thereafter will be eligible for reimbursement of reasonable litigation expenses pursuant to the Court's Reimbursement Guidelines for Volunteer Counsel. Under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 45(d)(3)(A), a Court must quash or modify a subpoena if the subpoena: "(i) fails to allow a reasonable time to comply; (ii) requires a person to comply beyond the geographical limits specified in Rule 45(c); (iii) requires disclosure of privileged or other protected matter; or (iv) subjects a person to undue burden." In the Motion, Third-Party Orit Tal requests the Court quash "the request for an in-person deposition and allow a Zoom deposition to proceed," due to certain personal circumstances (i.e., caring for her elderly father and repeated domestic and foreign travel) and purported improper service of process. ECF No. 21 at 3. The record reflects, however, that Ms. Tal was properly served with the underlying subpoena in May 2022 (or, alternatively, has waived any challenge to the propriety of service), and her noncompliance is the basis for these proceedings. See ECF Nos. 1-3 at 2; 27 at 2; 32 at 2 ("Ms. Galapo does not contest that she was served with the initial Illinois subpoena at 21218 Northeast 31st Place, Aventura, Florida ('Aventura Residence') on May 26, 2022."). Additionally, Ms. Tal is a resident

		of Miami-Dade County, <i>see</i> ECF No. 32 at 4, so the request for an in-person deposition in Broward County falls within the geographical limits set forth in Rule 45(c). Moreover, Ms. Tal has not alleged that the subpoena seeks disclosure of privileged or other protected matter. Lastly, the subpoena provides reasonable notice and would not subject Ms. Tal to undue burden. Thus, in the interest of efficient case management and to promote the administration of justice, the Motion is <b>DENIED</b> .
		Similarly, the Court <b>DENIES</b> Ms. Tal's request, first made in the Reply Memorandum, to vacate the Court's previous Orders finding her in contempt of Court. See ECF No. 32 at 1 (Reply Memorandum); see also ECF Nos. 11, 13 (previous contempt Orders); S.D. Fla. L.R. 7.1(c)(1) ("The movant may file and serve a reply memorandum in support of the motion, which reply memorandum shall be strictly limited to rebuttal of matters raised in the memorandum in opposition"); Baltzer v. Midland Credit Mgmt., Inc., No. 14-20140-CIV, 2014 WL 3845449, at *1 (S.D. Fla. Aug. 5, 2014) (discussing Local Rule 7.1(c) and noting "[a] reply memorandum may not raise new arguments or evidence").
		Accordingly, Third-Party Orit Tal must appear for an in-person deposition within <b>14 days</b> from the date of this Order, unless extended by agreement of the parties. Failure to do so may result in additional more severe sanctions, including holding Ms. Tal in custody until she purges herself of contempt by complying with this Court's Orders. 		The undersigned finds that, in the interest of efficient case management and to promote the administration of justice, the Court should determine the Motion to Dismiss prior to making any further findings regarding contempt. Accordingly, the undersigned defers further recommendations regarding additional findings of contempt against Ms. Galapo until the Court rules on 21 Ms. Galapo's Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Proper Service. Upon a ruling on 21 Ms. Galapo's Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Proper Service, Petitioner may renew her request for additional findings of civil contempt, including seeking additional sanctions, increased per diem fines, and possible arrest/incarceration of Ms. Galapo until she appears for her deposition. To be clear, this Order does not modify 13 the District Judge's prior Order, which found Ms. Galapo in contempt for failure to appear for deposition and imposed a \$200/day fine until she is deposed. That Order remains in effect and fines continue to accrue. To date, Ms. Galapo has amassed \$60,400 in fines (\$200 per day x 302 days).
