

ORDER OF APPOINTMENT


Upon consideration of the fact that the President of the United States, Ronald Reagan, has appointed the Honorable Stanley Marcus as United States District Judge for the Southern District of Florida, and that the said Stanley Marcus has tendered his resignation as United States Attorney for the Southern District of Florida, effective upon his taking the oath of office as United States District Judge on August 16, 1985; it is, pursuant to the authority vested in this Court by 28 U.S.C. §546:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Leon B. Kellner, Esq., Executive Assistant United States Attorney, be and he is hereby appointed United States Attorney of and for the Southern District of Florida, effective at 12:00 noon, August 16, 1985. The said Leon B. Kellner, Esq., by the unanimous decision of the thirteen active and two senior United States District Judges of this court, by this order, shall be fully empowered to exercise the duties and authorities of the office of the United States

Attorney for the Southern District of Florida, until such time as his successor may be appointed and duly sworn.
