ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

A certified copy of a judgment entered by the Supreme Court of the State of Florida dated October 6, 1988, has been filed with this court. This judgement states, in part:

" . . .we approve the referee's report in finding Keane guilty of fifteen acts of misconduct but disapprove the recommended sanction. Keane is hereby disbarred from the practice of law, effective from March 4, 1985, the date this Court suspended him. Keane will not be allowed to apply for readmission until five years from that date. Judgment for costs in the amount of \$3,936.01 is entered against Keane, for which sum let execution issue."

Therefore, pursuant to the Rules of Disciplinary Enforcement, United States District Court, Southern District of Florida, Rule 2(B), you are directed to file with this court, within 30 days after service of this Order to Show Cause, why the imposition of the identical discipline by this court would be unwarranted and the reasons therefore.

Thereafter, pursuant to Rule 2(D), this court shall impose the identical discipline unless any element in Subparagraph (D) exists, at which time the court shall enter such other order as is appropriate.
