Concerning Scott William Katz, Esquire


On Wednesday March 15, 1989, upon a vote of the judges of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, a Bar Review Committee was formed with regard to the earlier disbarment of attorney Scott William Katz by the Florida Bar Association.

Judge Thomas E. Scott is appointed chairman of the Bar Review Committee. Judge Stanley Marcus and Senior Judge C. Clyde Atkins are appointed committee members. Judge Kenneth L. Ryskamp is appointed alternate committee member.

The following procedures will apply:

1. Written notice shall be given to the attorney in question ordering that within 30 days, he or she shall file a written response with the Clerk of Court, as to why disbarment should not take place. Failure to so respond within the time limit will result in immediate disbarment.
2. Upon receipt of a timely response, the Clerk of Court shall issue a notice of hearing to be held before two United States District Judges designated by the chairman, and recorded by a certified shorthand reporter.
3. Based upon the written response and oral presentation of the attorney in question, the Bar Review Committee will make their recommendations to the Court.
