
Upon consideration, it is

WILDLIFE/PROPERTY FORFEITURE ORDER

Unless otherwise specifically ordered by a United States Court of the Southern District of Florida, any wildlife or property which has been seized within the jurisdiction of the Southern District of Florida under the authority of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, 16 USC 703-711; the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act, 16 USC 668dd-668ee; the Eagle Protection Act, 16 USC 668-668e; the Endangered Species Act, 16 USC 1531-1542; the Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act, 16 USC 718-718i; the Airborne Hunting Act, 16 USC 742j-1; the Marine Mammal Protection Act, 16 USC 1361-1407; the Lacey Act, 18 USC 42 or the Lacey Act Amendments of 1981, 16 USC 3371-3378, where final disposition of the case has been made by either payment of a forfeiture of collateral or a judgment by the Court on behalf of the Government and where so authorized by statute, such wildlife or property shall be forfeited to the U.S. Government and disposed of by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service in such a manner as described by Title 50, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 12.
