
O R D E R

This matter having come before the Court upon the recommendation of Matthew S. Balch, Acting Clerk for the Southern District of Florida, that BARNET I. ABRAMOWITZ, Official Court Reporter in the Southern District of New York, be accepted by transfer for appointment as Official Court Reporter in the Southern District of Florida, Miami Division, and the Court being satisfied that Barnet I. Abramowitz meets the requirements for such appointment, it is, therefore,
