ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 91-20

Change of Criminal
Case Category

Pursuant to our blind random assignment system, the United States Attorney is to submit a Certificate of Trial Attorney simultaneously with the filing of a criminal indictment or information. This Certificate is used by the Clerk of Court to ascertain the category of each case for random assignment to the court. Judge Edward B. Davis was randomly assigned 89-712-CR. This case, which was originally filed in Criminal Category I, required 31 days of trial, fulfilling the requirements for a Category IV case.

Therefore, the Clerk of Court is hereby directed to credit Judge Davis in Criminal Category IV, and debit in Category I upon the next refilling of the Categories IV and I/II assignment wheels.
