
**IN RE: ASSIGNMENT OF CASES TO  
MAGISTRATE JUDGE STEPHEN T. BROWN**

Magistrate Judge Stephen T. Brown having been appointed as a magistrate judge for the Southern Division of this Court, and based upon the decisions reached by the Court regarding Magistrate Judge Brown's duties, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that in order to assign a full complement of cases to Magistrate Judge Brown in the shortest period of time, our random assignment method for the assignment of cases to Magistrate Judge Turnoff, Magistrate Judge Johnson, and Magistrate Judge Bandstra will be temporarily suspended until such time as Magistrate Judge Brown receives a total of cases equal to the average number of cases assigned to each magistrate less 10% (439 cases). At that time, the normal process will resume and all magistrates will, once again, receive case assignments on a totally random basis.
