
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 92-56

**IN RE: CHANGE OF CRIMINAL
CASE CATEGORY**

Pursuant to our blind random assignment system, the United States Attorney is to submit a Certificate of Trial Attorney simultaneously with the filing of a criminal indictment or information. This Certificate is used by the Clerk of Court to ascertain the category of each case for random assignment to the court. The two cases listed below have exceeded the estimated trial time. Therefore, the Clerk of Court is hereby directed to effectuate the necessary category changes, issuing the appropriate credits and debits upon the next refilling of the Criminal Categories I/II, III and IV assignment wheels, for the following:
