**IN RE: ASSIGNMENT OF MIAMI
CRIMINAL CASES TO CHIEF JUDGE
NORMAN C. ROETTGER**

It is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that effective with the refilling of the next category I/II criminal wheel in Miami, and at each refilling thereafter, the Clerk of Court shall restructure the case assignment system to allow the Chief Judge to be assigned six Miami criminal cases on the assumption that will produce an average of about two per month. The Clerk of Court shall accordingly debit six ballots in the category I/II criminal wheel in Fort Lauderdale for Chief Judge Roettger.

This is being done in keeping with my policy as Chief Judge to try some cases in each division of the district.
