



Due to the voluntary transfer of Magistrate Judge Linnea R. Johnson's duty station from Miami to West Palm Beach, it is hereby


**ORDERED** that the Clerk of Court is directed to revise the civil and criminal case assignment systems such that Magistrate Judge Johnson will receive the following assignments effective April 1, 1999:

- a) Judge William P. Dimitrouleas' civil referrals
- b) Judge Kenneth L. Ryskamp's criminal referrals
- c) Senior Judge James C. Paine's civil and criminal referrals with the exception of all Fort Pierce Division cases
- d) One-half of criminal duty coverage in West Palm Beach
- e) Any criminal case in which Magistrate Judge Ann E. Vitunac enters an Order of Recusal
- f) Judge Hurley's civil consent trials in cases where the lawyers do not want a trial in Fort Pierce

The assignments to the other Northern Division Magistrate Judges will be modified accordingly, and the Clerk of Court shall take whatever steps necessary to implement this order.
