

01-CV-2479, Gutierrez-Gamboa v. United States


It is further **ORDERED** that all matters presently pending in the following closed cases will be likewise transferred to the Honorable Shelby Highsmith forthwith:

Magistrate Judge Andrea Simonton, who was formerly paired with Judge Nesbitt, shall remain the assigned Magistrate for all purposes on all cases herein transferred, except for that class of

pro se prisoner cases that are normally assigned to Magistrate Judge Charlene Sorrentino pursuant to Administrative Orders Numbers 89-31 and 96-55, which shall remain with Judge Sorrentino.
