

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2003-79

In Re: Determining Officer Regarding
Disclosure of Pretrial Services and
Probation Information



IT IS HEREBY ORDERED commencing August 1, 2003, that the Determining Officer regarding requests for disclosure of information or records kept during the course of the normal business of the United States Pretrial Services Office shall be the Chief Pretrial Services Officer, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the Determining Officer regarding requests for disclosure of information or records kept during the course of the normal business of the United States Probation Office shall be the Chief Probation Officer, pursuant to the New Rules on Disclosure which were issued by the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts on April 25, 2003.
