

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2005-21

IN RE:

APPOINTMENT OF AD HOC COMMITTEE FOR
SELECTION OF CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER



Frank Schwartz has served as Chief Probation Officer since his appointment to the position of Acting Chief Probation Officer in October 1994. Chief Schwartz has informed the Court of his intention to retire from service during the first quarter of calendar year 2006. To insure the orderly transition of duties from Chief Schwartz to his successor, it is hereby

ORDERED that an Ad Hoc Committee for the Selection of a Chief Probation Officer be created. The Committee shall be responsible for coordinating posting of the Chief Probation Officer position announcement, screening applicants for the position, interviewing those applicants deemed most qualified, and recommending to the Court three names to be considered by the full Court for the position of Chief Probation Officer. It is further

ORDERED that the Committee be comprised of Judge Donald L. Graham, Chairman, Judge K. Michael Moore, Judge Patricia A. Seitz, Senior Judge Shelby Highsmith, Magistrate Judge Robert L. Dubé, and Chief Probation Officer Frank Schwartz. The Ad Hoc Committee will cease to exist upon the appointment of a successor to Mr. Schwartz.
