

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2008-14

**IN RE: REVISION TO MIAMI MAGISTRATE
JUDGE PAIRINGS REGARDING RECUSALS**



On December 20, 2007, this Court entered Administrative Order 2007-68 establishing new pairings as to the Miami Magistrate Judges. Upon further review, some minor adjustments regarding recusals are necessary to the pairings as stated in that earlier Order. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

Paragraph III of Administrative Order 2007-68 is stricken and replaced by the following:

III. All recusals by Miami Magistrate Judges shall be assigned to Magistrate Judge William C. Turnoff. Any recusal by Magistrate Judge Turnoff shall be randomly assigned to another Miami Magistrate Judge from the Miami Magistrate Judge recusal wheel. (Recalled Magistrate Judges Palermo and Dubé shall not be included in the Miami recusal wheel.) In the unlikely event that all Miami Magistrate Judges recuse, the matter shall be randomly assigned from the Northern Division Magistrate Judge recusal wheel.

In all other respects, Administrative Order 2007-68 shall remain in full force and effect.
