

**IN RE: REALIGNMENT OF FORT
LAUDERDALE MAGISTRATE JUDGE
PAIRING ASSIGNMENT**



Administrative Order 2007-68 modified this Court's Magistrate Judge Pairing Assignment Plan effective April 1, 2008 for three years. After consideration of all relevant factors, the Magistrate Judges' Committee recommends realignment of Magistrate Judges Snow and Rosenbaum in the Fort Lauderdale Division. Accordingly, it is

If recusal is necessary, the case will then be reassigned consistent with prior recusal policies.
