

It has been shown to the Court that the Supreme Court of Florida has permanently disbarred the above-named attorney from practicing law in Florida, effective immediately following a January 29, 2009, order. On June 25, 2009, Mr. Cohn was served by mail with an Order to Show Cause why this Court should not impose the same discipline, accompanied by the Supreme Court of Florida's Order of Disbarment. As of the date of this Order, more than 60 days have passed with no response from Mr. Cohn. Pursuant to the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline, United States District Court, Southern District of Florida, it is ORDERED that said attorney be disbarred from practice in this Court, effective immediately.

It is ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall strike Lee Arman Cohn from the roll of attorneys for the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that said attorney advise the Clerk of the Court of all pending cases before this Court in which he is counsel or co-counsel of record.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that the Clerk of Court mail Lee Arman Cohn a copy of this Order of Disbarment.
