

ORDER ON SCOTT NOTICE OF ANCILLARY PROCEEDING

On October 31, 2011, this Court received a Notice of Ancillary Proceeding from the above-named attorney regarding a Motion to Vacate Opinion of Suspension on Newly Discovered Evidence filed with the Florida Supreme Court. Within this "Notice," Scott twice requests this Court to allow him a hearing in response to this Court's October 14, 2010 Order of Suspension, which was based upon the Florida Supreme Court's three (3) year suspension of Scott in The Florida Bar v. Scott, 39 So. 3d 309 (Fla. 2010). If this "Notice" is construed as a motion for rehearing or reconsideration, this would be Scott's fourth such motion and first after this Court, in its January 25, 2011 Order, cautioned against the filing of future multiple successive motions. Scott grounds his request for a hearing on the allegation that he was not aware of the use of Rule 4-8.4(c) of the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar in support of his state discipline. However, both the May 22, 2009 Amended Report of Referee and June 10, 2010 Florida Supreme Court Order of Suspension mention Rule 4-8.4(c) as one of the grounds for his suspension. Scott has not raised any new issues that would warrant reconsideration of this Court's October 14th Order under Rule 5(e) of the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline.

Any further multiple successive motions, regardless of form, will not be entertained by this Court and pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 11 and this Court's inherent power, the filing of such may result in sanctions.

Given this background, and the Court being fully advised of the matter, it is

ORDERED that Scott's request for a hearing in his Notice of Ancillary Proceeding is DENIED.
