

OF THE CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISED
RELEASE AND PROBATION OF A
JUDGMENT AND COMMITMENT ORDER**




Consistent with the Judicial Conference of the United States' position that the time requirement imposed on offenders be raised from the present five day period, it is

ORDERED that standard condition number two of the Judgment in a Criminal Case be amended in all cases ordered in the future, to require all defendants to submit a monthly supervision report within the first fifteen days of every month, rather than the previous five-day period. Those defendants subject to a period of supervision who were sentenced under previous Judgment Orders that required reporting within the first five days of every month will also be subject to this amendment and must report within the first fifteen days of every month.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
