IN RE: AMENDED MAGISTRATE
JUDGE PAIRING ASSIGNMENT PLAN

Due to the shifting caseloads and in the interest of judicial economy, the Court finds it appropriate to amend the Magistrate Judge Pairing Assignment Plan in the Southern District of Florida effective September 23, 2013. Wherefore, it is

ORDERED that Magistrate Judge Barry Garber be paired with District Judge Jose E. Martinez on all criminal matters and Social Security Appeals effective August 1, 2013. All Social Security Appeals pending before Magistrate Judge Chris McAliley will be reassigned to Magistrate Judge Barry Garber. In addition, Magistrate Judge Garber has agreed to take the three duty weeks that remain in the year 2013 (September 3, November 12, and December 2) that were previously assigned to Magistrate Judge McAliley.
