

**ORDER ON PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT**

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on attorney Kevin John Taylor's Petition for Reinstatement as a member of the Bar of this Court. That Petition was referred to the Court's Ad Hoc Committee for Attorney Admissions, Peer Review and Attorney Grievance. On August 19, 2013, the Committee issued a Report and Recommendation finding that Mr. Taylor had made the necessary showing for readmission to the Court's Bar and recommending that he be reinstated pursuant to Rule IX (c) of this Court's Rules Governing Attorney Discipline.
